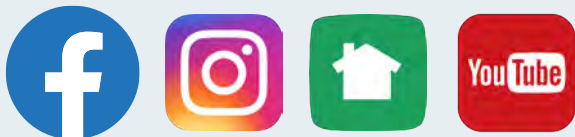

From the Desk of the Village President



I hoped you enjoyed the Village's 100th anniversary celebration in August. It was a wonderful weekend and I heard so many positive comments, especially about the drone show. We celebrate a lot of special events in Sussex, but that was a special moment. Sussex is a great community, and we have so much to look forward to in our next 100 years.

I'm excited to share with you that we will be starting Phase B of the Village Park rehabilitation project. Village Park is an essential part of our community and in 2028 we will celebrate the park's 70th anniversary. Over the next several years we'll be tackling different facilities in Village Park that need to be refreshed/updated to reflect the community's needs. Over the course of 2024, a citizen advisory committee reviewed and analyzed the park's main rental shelter. The citizen panel recommended to the Park Board a new shelter, and the Park Board and Village Board have now accepted their recommendation.

Starting after Lions Daze in 2025, the Village will replace the 1986 open air shelter with The Ridge at Village Park, a park pavilion with bathrooms, indoor space, and a stage for the many community events that are held throughout the year at Village Park. Pictures of the facility are on the village website. In addition, the Village's 1979 park shop will be replaced with a new facility to meet the operational needs of the Parks Department. The Village plans to bid these projects together to gain efficiencies in construction costs and we hope for the projects to be open for the community in June of 2026.

2025 will see our neighborhood road program head to the northern portion of the Village. Neighborhoods such as Coldwater Creek, Pine Ridge, Majestic Heights, Braddock Place, and Ridgeview will have maintenance done on utilities and the road resurfaced. A lot of work will impact the stormwater system. Woodside Road will be part of this project, and the Village plans to create a separation between the sidewalk and roadway along Woodside Road, which is a frequent concern we've heard. If you live in the project area look for a postcard/letter about a road program meeting in late February/early March to discuss the project with the contractor and Village staff.

As 2024 winds down, I want to thank you all for choosing Sussex—100 years strong and a bright future ahead.

Property Taxes

Property tax bills are mailed by Waukesha County by the third Monday in December, based on information on file at the Register of Deeds office on November 1.

Tax bills can be paid in two ways:

- in full by January 31;
- or in three installment payments, due January 31, March 31 and May 31. If an installment payment is missed, the entire balance becomes due with penalties.

Winter Parking Restrictions Now in Effect

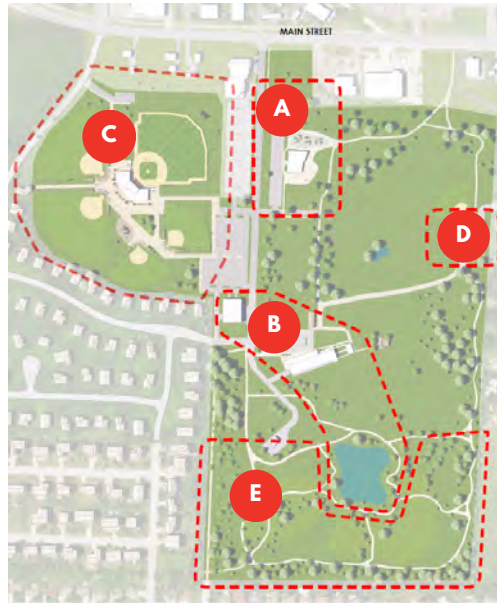
Winter Parking Restrictions are in effect from November 1 through March 31. On-street parking is not allowed between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. during this time.

If you or a guest would like to park on the road for longer than 30 minutes between the hours of 2 and 6 a.m. during the winter, you must call **(262) 246-5237** to request permission. You will need to give your name, car make and model, license plate, phone number, and the address where your car is parked. Failure to request permission could result in a citation. Residents are permitted three parking exceptions per month.

Exciting Developments Coming to Village Park in 2025–2026

Village Park Master Plan Phasing

- Phase A - 2020
 - The Grove: Pavilion, Indoor Rentable Space, Multi-Sport Courts, Splash Pad, Inclusive Playground
- Phase B - 2025
 - The Ridge: Indoor Rentable Space, Pavilion with Stage, Play Area; Maintenance Facility; Retention Pond
- Phase C - 2026
 - Baseball Complex
- Phase D - 2027
 - East Pavilion
- Phase E - 2027-2028
 - Natural Area



The Village is in the process of upgrading Village Park in light of its 70th anniversary in 2028.

In 2025 this will mean Phase B work with the establishment of the Ridge at Village Park as the main pavilion for Village Park, a Parks Maintenance Facility, and infrastructure upgrades. See more details about the projects below.

Village Park draws thousands of visitors each year and plays an important role in our local economy, as data shows folks regularly visit restaurants and other businesses after leaving the park. The park hosts numerous community events as well as larger regional events. As such Village Park will remain open to the public during these projects, but portions of the park may be restricted for safety reasons and access may come from Sunset at points in construction. The Village website and social media will be the best sources of information about the projects once they get underway.

The Village plans to bid these projects together to gain efficiencies in construction costs and the Phase B projects should be open for the community by July 1, 2026.

The Ridge

The Ridge will take advantage of the natural ridgeline to provide amazing views of the park from the new shelter. The pavilion will feature an indoor rental space of approximately 2,000 square feet, complete with a concession stand.

The outdoor area will span over 8,500 square feet, making it suitable for events of various sizes.

A detached, covered stage will provide a versatile venue for the multitude of community special events held in our park each year.

The parking lot will be adequately sized for the facility's needs, while larger events will still utilize the park's grassy areas.



Parks Maintenance Facility

The new Parks Maintenance Facility is designed to meet the essential needs of the department, offering sufficient space to maintain and store vehicles and equipment outside of the elements, conveniently located near the Village's main park operations.
