CHARTER ORDINANCE NUMBER 28

PROVIDING FOR COMBINING THE OFFICE OF
VILLAGE CLERK AND VILLAGE TREASURER

The Village Board of the Village of Sussex do hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to ss. 61.195, 61.197 and 66.01 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Village of Sussex hereby elects not to be governed by those portions of ss. 61.19, 61.23 and sub. (2) of s. 61.25 of the Statutes which relate to the selection and tenure of the clerk and the treasurer and which are in conflict with this ordinance.

SECTION 2. The offices of clerk and treasurer are hereby combined and hereafter instead of being elected as provided in s. 61.19 of the Statutes, the office of clerk-treasurer shall be appointed by the Village President with the approval of the majority of the members of the Village Board.

SECTION 3. The said clerk-treasurer shall hold office for an indefinite term, subject to removal by law.

SECTION 4. Such person so appointed to perform the duties of the combined offices shall perform all duties required of both offices as provided by law and such other duties as are requested to be executed by him by the Village Board from time to time.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall not curtail the right of the incumbents to complete the current terms as clerk and treasurer.

SECTION 6. This is a charter ordinance and shall take effect after it shall have been submitted to a referendum of the electors and approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.
