
Dear Resident:

Beginning January 1, 2023, Badgerland Disposal, an LRS Company, will replace Johns Disposal as the trash/recycling curbside collection service for all one- to four-family residences in the Village of Sussex.

As part of this change, the Village will change from two collection days (Monday and Thursday) to four (Monday-Thursday), which means you will likely have a new collection day. Both trash and recycling service will continue to be offered weekly (see collection schedule below). Larger, more detailed maps are available on the Village website ([www.villagesussex.org](http://www.villagesussex.org)). You will also receive new trash and recycling carts and your Johns carts will be collected. Please read the back page for more information.

**Collection Days and Map**

Monday (blue)	North of Good Hope Road.
Tuesday (yellow)	South of Good Hope Road and north of the Union Pacific Railroad.
Wednesday (green)	South of the Union Pacific Railroad and north of Main Street. South of Main Street and east of Maple Avenue.
Thursday (pink)	South of Main Street and west of Maple Avenue.



## Cart Distribution and Collection

Your new carts will be delivered to your curb by the last week in December for use in January. The carts are the same size and you will again receive two carts, one for trash and one for recycling.

Johns Disposal will collect your current/old carts during the final collection the last week of December. Because they plan to follow the trash/recycling trucks to collect the carts, it is possible that collection may take additional days that week. If your trash/recycling isn't collected on your regular service day, please leave it at the curb for collection the following day.



## Collection Program Guidelines

- Containers should be placed 3 feet apart and 3 feet from any obstruction—walking between containers is a good rule of thumb—or place one container on the left side of the driveway and the other container on the right. Containers should also be out of the road, especially during leaf collection and snow plowing season.
- Trash and recycling must be curbside by 7 a.m. on your designated collection day.
- All waste/recycling materials must be INSIDE of the carts. Waste outside of the carts will not be taken.
- When holidays fall on a weekday, collection will be delayed one day.

## Waste (Trash, Garbage, Refuse)

Your trash cart will be serviced weekly based on the enclosed calendar/schedule for your address. Solid waste is what most of us think of as “trash” “refuse” or “garbage” that is produced at home, work or leisure. *This category does NOT include any of the recyclable items listed below, any household hazardous waste, liquid latex paint, yard waste, appliances, or electronics.*

### DO NOT PLACE THESE ITEMS IN THE TRASH CONTAINER

- Dirt, sod, leaves, grass clippings
- Household hazardous waste
- Concrete, rock
- Construction or demolition debris
- Banned electronic waste
- Hot ashes or flammable materials such as oil, gas or paint, batteries, engine parts or tires

## Recycling

Your recycling cart will be serviced weekly based on the enclosed calendar/schedule for your address.

### The following items are banned from Wisconsin landfills and should be placed in your recycling cart for proper processing, handling and/or reuse

- Aluminum containers, glass containers, steel containers (tin/aluminum cans)
- Bi-metal containers (i.e. containers made from a combination of steel and aluminum)
- Corrugated cardboard (all corrugated cardboard cut into pieces no larger than 3'x3')
- Magazines and other materials printed on similar paper
- Newspaper and other materials printed on newsprint
- Mixed paper
- Plastic containers #1–#7 (milk jugs, laundry detergent bottles, soda and water bottles, etc.)

## Bulk Item Collection

Badgerland Disposal will provide monthly bulk item pick-up service. Each household is allowed up to 10 bulk items each month at no additional cost. These item(s) must be manageable by one person and must be scheduled 48 hours in advance via email or phone call to allow proper equipment for pick up. This service includes items such as tables, lamps, tires (maximum two per month and six per year per household), furniture, appliances, mattresses, etc. *No waste oil, liquids, batteries, or e-waste.* Badgerland will collect additional items over 10 for a fee. Place bulk item(s) next to your container on bulk pick up day so they are visible for the driver.
