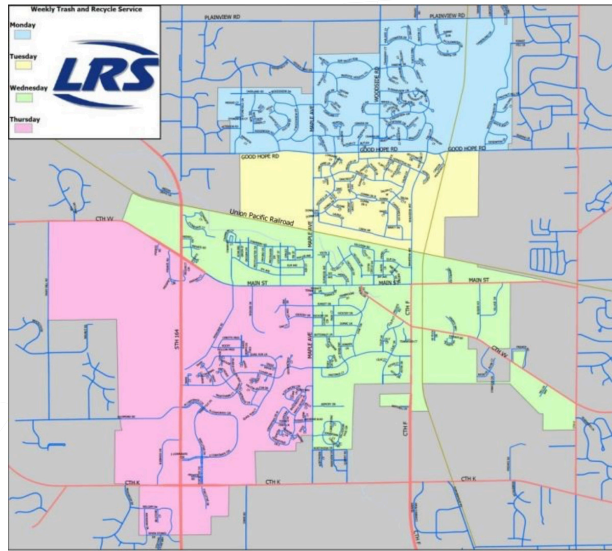

Badgerland Disposal, an LRS Company, is proud to announce new curbside collection service for residents in the Village of Sussex, beginning in January 2023. Badgerland Disposal/LRS will provide weekly refuse and recycling collection for all residents.

## COLLECTION GUIDELINES

Beginning January 1st, 2023, the Village of Sussex will be transitioning from a two (2) day collection schedule to a four (4) day collection schedule. As a result, your service day is subject to change. Please reference the map on the back page or a larger more detailed version is available on the Village website ([www.VillageSussex.org](http://www.VillageSussex.org)).

<b>Monday</b>	North of Good Hope Road.
<b>Tuesday</b>	South of Good Hope Road and north of the Union Pacific Railroad.
<b>Wednesday</b>	South of the Union Pacific Railroad and north of Main Street. South of Main Street and east of Maple Avenue.
<b>Thursday</b>	South of Main Street and west of Maple Avenue.

- All items need to be placed out to the curb by 7 AM.
- Garbage and recycling will be collected weekly, starting Monday, January 2nd.
- All materials need to be inside the cart for service. Anything outside of the cart will be left behind.
- Containers should be placed 3 feet apart and 3 feet from any obstruction. Walking between containers is a good rule of thumb. We also suggest placing one container on the left side of the driveway and the other container on the right.
- Containers should be off the road, especially during leaf collection and snow plowing season.
- On holiday weeks we operate on a one-day delay, when the holiday falls on a weekday.

## LRS/BADGERLAND CART DISTRIBUTION AND JOHN'S CART COLLECTION

Your new LRS/Badgerland Disposal carts will be delivered to your curb by the last week in December for use in January. The carts are the same size, and you will again receive two carts, one for trash and one for recycling. Johns Disposal will collect your current/old carts during the final collection the last week of December. It is possible that collection may take additional days that week because Johns Disposal plans to follow the trash/recycling trucks to collect the carts. If your trash/recycling isn't collected on your regular service day, please leave it at the curb for collection the following day.

## GARBAGE SERVICE

Solid waste is what most of us think of as "trash" "refuse" or "garbage" that is produced at home, work, or leisure. This category does NOT include the recyclable items, any household hazardous waste, liquid latex paint, yard waste, appliances, or electronics. Badgerland/LRS offers wheeled carts for garbage with a flip-top lid and handlebar to throw your garbage in. All garbage will be collected between the times of 7AM and 7PM on your collection day. Service times are subject to change. Your trash will be serviced weekly on your designated day. Anything not contained in the cart or on the list of non-accepted materials will be left behind.

## RECYCLING SERVICE

Your recycling cart will be serviced weekly based on the calendar/schedule for your address. Please see below guidelines for materials that should be placed in your recycling cart and not the trash.

- Aluminum containers, glass containers, steel containers (tin/aluminum Cans)
- Bi-metal containers (i.e., containers made from a combination of steel and aluminum)
- Corrugated cardboard (all corrugated cardboard cut into pieces no larger than 3'x3')
- Magazines and other materials printed on similar paper
- Newspaper and other materials printed on newsprint
- Plastic containers #1-#7 (milk jugs, laundry detergent bottles, soda and water bottles, etc.)

## BULK ITEM SERVICE

"Bulk Items" are items that are too large to fit into a cart. Bulk item examples include tables, lamps, tires (2 per month/6 total per year per household), furniture, appliances, mattresses, etc. No waste oil, liquids, batteries, or e-waste. Each household is allowed up to 10 bulk items each month at no additional cost. Bulk item(s) must be manageable by one person and must be scheduled 48 hours in advance via email or phone call, to allow proper equipment for pick up. Place bulk item(s) next to your container on bulk pick up day so they are visible for the driver.

## NON-ACCEPTED MATERIAL

Please note Badgerland Disposal and LRS will not handle these items for curbside pickup:

- **NO HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE:** No flammable materials such as oil, gas or paint, batteries, banned electronic waste, engine parts or tires.
- **NO YARD WASTE:** No grass clippings, leaves, branches, soil, dirt, sod, hot ashes or any accumulated yard waste as a result of the cultivation and maintenance of lawns, shrubbery, vines, trees and gardens.
- **NO CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS:** No concrete, rock, demolition debris or large construction waste items. If you need assistance with disposing of or drop-off location suggestions for any of the above materials, please contact customer service.
